

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT PRIMARY SCHOOL ENROLMENT

When enrolling your child in primary school you will be asked to provide evidence of your child's immunisation status in one of the following ways:

- If all of your child's immunisation history is recorded on the Australian Childhood Immunisation Register (ACIR), a Child History Statement is automatically issued on completion of the 4 year immunisation; if you do not receive a Child History Statement, you can visit a Medicare office to obtain a copy or phone 1800 653 809.
- If your child's immunisation history is not fully recorded on ACIR, an Immunisation Status Certificate can be provided by your local council on provision of immunisation records.

FREE immunisation is available for your child against –

- Polio
- Rubella
- Measles
- Tetanus
- Mumps
- Diphtheria
- Whooping Cough

and for specific age groups –

- Hepatitis B
- Varicella
- Meningococcal C
- Pneumococcal
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV)
- Rotavirus
- Haemophilus Influenzae Type B
