- 2.1 Resolves to enter into a New Lease Agreement (New Lease) with Jemena Electricity Networks (Vic) Limited (Jemena) in accordance with section 190 of the Local Government Act 1989 (the Act) and section 66 (1) Transfer of Land Act 1958 (Transfer Act) for part of the land located at 42 Macedon Street, Sunbury being part of land in certificate of title volume 8895 folio 824 being Crown Allotment 8 on title plan 885976Y (Subject Land) and as shown in Attachment 1.
- 2.2 Gives public notice in accordance with Section 190 and 223 of the Act of its intention to enter into a New Lease with Jemena for the Subject Land.
- 2.3 Authorises the Chief Executive Officer to undertake the administrative procedures to enable Council to carry out its functions under section 190 and section 223 of the Act, in relation to this matter.
- 2.4 Consider any submissions received pursuant to section 223 of the Act at a meeting to be held before a Committee of the Whole Council (if required).
- 2.5 Should there be no submissions received, Council approves the proposal and signs and seals the relevant New Lease documents.
- 2.6 Notes the key terms of the New Lease will be as follows:
 - 2.6.1 The New Lease term shall be for thirty (30) years with one further term of twenty (20) years.
 - 2.6.2 The rent amount shall be for nil consideration.
 - 2.6.3 The permitted use is for an electrical substation and for other purposes incidental to the receiving, distributing, transforming and supplying of electricity.
- 2.7 Resolves to create an easement under Section 45(1) of the Transfer Act on the land described as part Crown Allotment 8 section 7 Township of Sunbury Parish of Buttlejorrk, Volume 8895 Folio 824 and known as 42 Macedon Street Sunbury (Council Chamber Land) for the purpose of electrical cabling and access to the electrical substation.
- 2.8 Resolves to lodge the Plan of Consolidation PC376954B to ensure that the whole land for the construction of the Hume Global Learning Centre Sunbury currently numbered as 44-48 Macedon Street is on a single title.
- 2.9 Authorises the Chief Executive Officer, or an approved delegate to sign any other documents in relation to the New Lease, creation of easement and the plan of consolidation.
