## Proceedings to be Recorded

The Chief Executive Officer reminded Councillors and members of the Gallery that a visual and audio recording of the Council meeting will be made and published to Council's website within 2 working days of the meeting.

#### **ORDER OF BUSINESS**

#### 1. PRAYER

Mr Domenic Isola, Chief Executive Officer, as the First Temporary Chairperson, read the Opening Prayer:

"Almighty God, we humbly beseech Thee to vouchsafe Thy blessing upon this Council. Direct and prosper its deliberations to the advancement of Thy glory and the true welfare of the people of the Hume City."

## 2. APPOINTMENT OF SECONDARY CHAIRPERSON

The Chief Executive Officer called for nominations for the Second Temporary Chairperson.

Cr Drew Jessop nominated Cr Ann Potter as the Second Temporary Chairperson. Cr Potter accepted the nomination.

There being no further nominations, Cr Potter was declared elected Second Temporary Chairperson. The First Temporary Chairperson vacated the Chair, and Cr Potter assumed the Chair.

#### 3. RECOGNITION OF TRADITIONAL LAND OWNERS

Cr Potter, as the Second Temporary Chairperson, read the following Recognition of Traditional Land Owners:

"We are meeting on country for which the members and elders of the Gunung-Willam-Balluk community and their forebears have been custodians for many centuries. The Gunung-Willum-Balluk of the Wurundjeri are the Traditional Custodians of this land. I would like to pay respect to the existing family members of the Gunung Willam Balluk and to Elders passed and present."

Cr Potter welcomed all present and formally acknowledged the former Hume City Council Mayors in attendance being Ms Casey Nunn, Mr Adem Atmaca, and former Councillors Mr Alan Bolton, and Mr Chandra Bamunusinghe who were seated in the gallery.

## 4. ELECTION OF THE MAYOR FOR THE 2019/2020 YEAR

The Second Temporary Chairperson invited nominations for the Office of Mayor for the 2019/2020 year.

Cr Jack Medcraft nominated Cr Carly Moore. Cr Carly Moore accepted the nomination.

There being no further nominations, the Second Temporary Chairperson declared Cr Moore to have been duly elected as the Mayor of Hume City for the 2019/2020 year.

The Second Temporary Chairperson vacated the Chair.

#### 5. INSTALLATION OF THE MAYOR

Cr Moore was presented with the Mayoral medallion, and in accordance with Section 73(2) of the Local Government Act 1989, assumed the Chair.

## ADDRESS BY THE MAYOR

The Mayor, Cr Carly Moore, addressed the meeting.

#### ADDRESS BY COUNCILLORS

Councillors Taylor, Jessop, Porter, Medcraft, Potter, Johnson, Sherry, Haweil, and Kurt, each in turn congratulated Cr Moore on being elected as Mayor for the 2019/2020 year.

## 6. ELECTION OF THE DEPUTY MAYOR FOR THE 2019/2020 YEAR

The Mayor referred to Cr Taylor who moved the following motion.

Moved Cr Jana Taylor, Seconded Cr Leigh Johnson

THAT there be two Deputy Mayors appointed for the 2019/2020 term.

**CARRIED** 

The Mayor declaring that there were now two vacant positions for Deputy Mayor for the 2019/2020 term, called for nominations.

Cr Jana Taylor nominated Cr Karen Sherry for the position of Deputy Mayor.

Cr Sherry accepted the nomination.

Cr Jodi Jackson nominated Cr Joseph Haweil for the position of Deputy Mayor.

Cr Haweil accepted the nomination.

Cr Leigh Johnson nominated Cr Jack Medcraft for the position of Deputy Mayor.

Cr Medcraft accepted the nomination.

There were no further nominations for the position of Deputy Mayor.

The Mayor proposed the following procedure for the election of the positions of Deputy Mayor:

That, as there are more nominations than there are positions vacant, separate elections are required for each available position for Deputy Mayor, and that any candidate receiving the majority of the votes of the number of Councillors present at the meeting will be duly elected as Deputy Mayor.

Votes will be by show of hand. If no candidate has the required majority of votes, then the Councillor with the least votes will be excluded and another vote between the remaining Councillors will be held, and if a candidate then has the required majority of the votes they will be declared elected.

If after a vote has been taken two or more candidates have tied votes, then the CEO will conduct a ballot to determine the result.

The Mayor sought any opposition from Councillors regarding this process for the election of the Deputy Mayors. No Councillors opposed the proposed process.

Councillors were then asked to vote for their preferred nominated candidate to fill the first vacant position of Deputy Mayor.

#### FIRST POSITION OF DEPUTY MAYOR

The Mayor advised that as Cr Sherry had been nominated first, she would be the first Councillor to be voted upon for the first vacant position of Deputy Mayor.

The vote was then undertaken, Councillor Karen Sherry received seven votes, being the required majority vote for the first vacant position of Deputy Mayor, and was declared the successful candidate.

No further vote for the first vacant position of Deputy Mayor was required.

Cr Jackson called a division on the vote. The results were:

## SECOND POSITION OF DEPUTY MAYOR

Councillors were then asked to vote on their preferred nominated candidate to fill the second vacant position of Deputy Mayor.

The Mayor advised that as Cr Haweil was second to be nominated that he would be the first Councillor to be voted upon for the second vacant position of Deputy Mayor.

The vote was undertaken, and Councillor Joseph Haweil receiving two votes, did not receive the majority vote to be elected to the role of Deputy Mayor.

The Mayor advised that the next vote would be for the next nominated candidate, being Cr Medcraft.

The vote was undertaken, Councillor Jack Medcraft received seven votes, being the majority vote for the second vacant position of Deputy Mayor, and was declared the successful candidate.
