



# STREET AND AREA BLITZ PROJECT FACT SHEET

To overcome some of the disadvantage in the 3047 postcode area of Broadmeadows, Dallas and Jacana, an initiative called Together 3047 has been created.

This program will deliver a range of projects to promote opportunities for local employment and training, improve housing diversity and enhance our streets and public spaces.

One of these is the Street and Area Blitz project.

## What is Street and Area Blitz project?

In order to improve the amenity of neighbourhoods and increase community pride, a series of clean-up blitzes will be undertaken by Hume City Council.

## What will it do?

Working with and on behalf of the community, Council will conduct a series of blitzes that focus on street trees, footpath repairs, naturestrip maintenance, graffiti removal and hard rubbish removal.

## How will it do this?

These goals will be achieved by:

- Calling for residents and interested community groups to be part of a clean-up of a street or area,
- Joint inspections of streets and areas between community representatives and Council staff,
- Notification to the community with a confirmed date for the blitz, and
- Evaluation questionnaires to gauge how it's tracking.
