

Financial hardship support

If you need support with your rates payments, there are a number of options available to you.

Set-up a payment plan online



You can apply for interest-free weekly, fortnightly or monthly direct debit payment plans to spread the payment of your rates.

Applications take around five minutes and you will need your property number listed on your rates and valuation notice.

In order to avoid paying interest on overdue rates, make sure to pay on time.

Waste Service Charge

From July 2023, the cost of waste and recycling services has been removed from general rates and become a separate Waste Service Charge.

Your rates notice now includes two new items – a kerbside waste fee and a public waste fee. The amount you pay in general rates has also been reduced.

The 2023/24 Budget will provide \$305 million for a variety of day-to-day services including our libraries, leisure centres, preschools, maternal and child health and aged and disability programs.

More than \$600 million in new funding will be invested in community facilities, roads, footpaths, parks and reserves over the next four years, including \$128 million in the next 12 months.

Council's general rate increase of 3.5% is in line with the Victorian Government's established Fair Go Rates System, and we will continue to review our services to ensure that they are delivered as efficiently and cost effectively as possible.

Our efforts are underpinned by the drive to create a thriving, inclusive and sustainable Hume for everyone.
