

Waste and recycling in Hume



Hume City is a beautiful place to live, work and visit. We all have a part to play in keeping our streets clean and environment healthy. **So let's work together to Keep Hume Clean.**

As a Hume resident you can use free Council services to help you get rid of your waste and recycling correctly.

Your household gets five waste vouchers to dispose of accepted waste that cannot go in household bins for FREE* every year.

This means you could get rid of up to 10 cubic metres of waste for FREE* every year by using your waste vouchers.

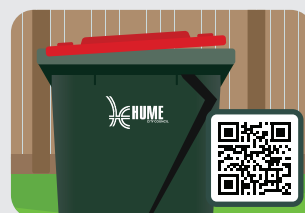

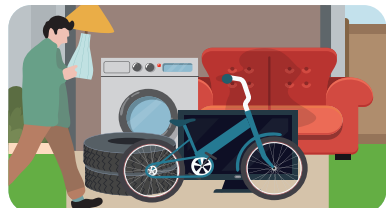

Book a waste collection

You can book FREE* hard waste and bundled branch collections each year using your waste vouchers.

**Limits and conditions apply.*



Hard waste collections

We can collect your unwanted furniture, appliances, electronics and other accepted items from your front yard or driveway.



Bundled branch collections

We can get collect your tree branches that are too big for your food and garden bin from your front yard or driveway.

The size of your collection will determine how many waste vouchers are used:

- **2 cubic metres = 1 waste voucher.**
Items must fit within a 2m x 1m x 1m (length x width x height) area.
- **4 cubic metres = 2 waste voucher.**
Items must fit within a 4m x 1m x 1m (length x width x height) area.



Please note:

- Only accepted items will be collected.
- Items placed on the nature strip without permission may incur fines.
- If you are unable to keep items in your front yard or driveway call Council before booking to discuss your options.

Let's work together to Keep Hume Clean



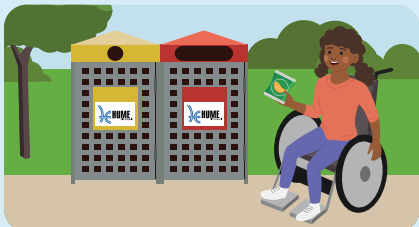
Keep bin lids closed and pick up any rubbish near your bins.

Return your shopping trolley to the trolley bay or retailer.



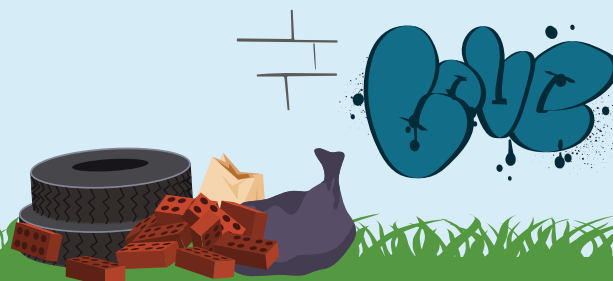
Use our public litter bins or take rubbish home with you.

Collected weekly



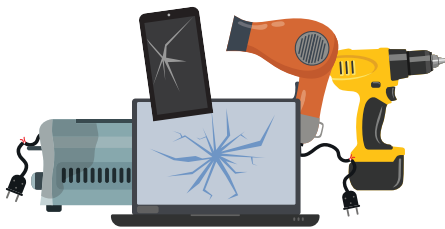
Recycling Bin
Collected fortnightly



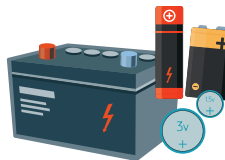
Food and Garden Bin

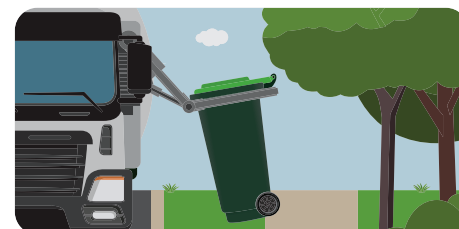
Small branches,

Moving house?



If you have moved into Hume:

- ✓ Check you have the following bins at your property:



1 x small
garbage bin



1 x large
recycling bin



1 x small OR large
food and garden bin



1 x kitchen caddy

If you are missing bins or have different sizes to the above please contact us. Extra bins and larger size bins incur additional costs.

- ✓ Get your waste vouchers allocated. If you are renting please provide a copy of your Rental Agreement. If you are a property owner please provide a copy of your Certificate of Occupancy or current rates notice. @contactus@hume.vic.gov.au

If you are moving house:

- ✓ Book a hard waste collection at least two weeks before you move (or earlier if moving in December or January) if you need to get rid of unwanted furniture or appliances. hume.vic.gov.au/hard-waste
- ✓ Take items to our Resource Recovery Centres. Check if you have remaining waste vouchers to drop off waste for free*: hardrubbishmelbourne.com.au/hume
- ✓ Check if there is an upcoming Hume Clean Day to drop-off mattresses and couches for free* at our Resource Recovery Centres. hume.vic.gov.au/hume-clean-day

Ensure all your waste is correctly disposed of before you move. Any items remaining after you leave is considered dumped rubbish and may incur a fine.

- ✓ Leave your bins and kitchen caddy behind; they remain at the property.
- ✓ If your bins have waste in them, put them out for collection on the day you move.
