

NO JOB NO PAY

To receive the Commonwealth Family Tax Benefit Part A and Child Care Rebate payments, children under 20 years must:

- be up to date with all their vaccinations
- have their vaccinations recorded on the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR).

NO JOB NO PLAY

Children enrolling in kindergarten, family day care or occasional care services must have an Immunisation History Statement issued by AIR demonstrating they are:

- up to date with all vaccinations for their age, or
- on a vaccination catch up plan, or
- have a valid medical condition preventing them from being fully vaccinated.

ENROLLING IN SCHOOL

Children enrolling in school must have an Immunisation History Statement issued by AIR.

OBTAINING AN IMMUNISATION HISTORY STATEMENT

An Immunisation History Statement can be obtained via:

- Medicare online through your myGov account
- Express Plus Medicare mobile app
- a Medicare service centre
- AIR on 1800 653 809.

COUNCIL IMMUNISATION SESSIONS PROVIDE ALL SCHEDULED VACCINES FREE FOR:

- babies, infants and young children
- secondary school students
- individuals under 20 years of age
- pregnant women
- medically at risk and other vulnerable individuals.

NO APPOINTMENT NECESSARY & VACCINES ARE FREE.

If you are unable to attend a session date allocated, you may attend any other council venue nearest to that date.

Babies can be immunised from 6 weeks of age (NO EARLIER).

12-month immunisations CANNOT be administered before a child's 1st birthday.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

After receiving any vaccination, children and adults should remain at the immunisation venue for at least 15 minutes to enable immediate attention in the event of any reaction.
