### Have your say on local traffic management

Dear resident,

**RE: LOCAL AREA TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT STUDY, CRAIGIEBURN EAST - PROPOSED TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PLAN**

As part of Hume City Council's ongoing commitment to Local Area Traffic Management (LATM), Council is undertaking a study of traffic issues within the Craigieburn East area bounded by Craigieburn Road, Bridgewater Road, Patullos Lane and Craigieburn Railway Line.

Between December 2018 and February 2019, Council sought community input into the LATM via an online mapping tool to identify areas for consideration or improvement. Approximately 50 areas/issues were identified by residents, plus further feedback and input received via Council's social media.

In addition to community input, the study has considered:

- Traffic speeds and volumes
- Casualty crashes
- Pedestrian and cycling connectivity
- Parking issues.

After considering this information, Council is proposing to install traffic treatments as shown on the enclosed Proposed Traffic Management Plan. These proposals are only preliminary, and before Council makes any decision on the treatments, we would like to hear your thoughts and opinions on what is being proposed.

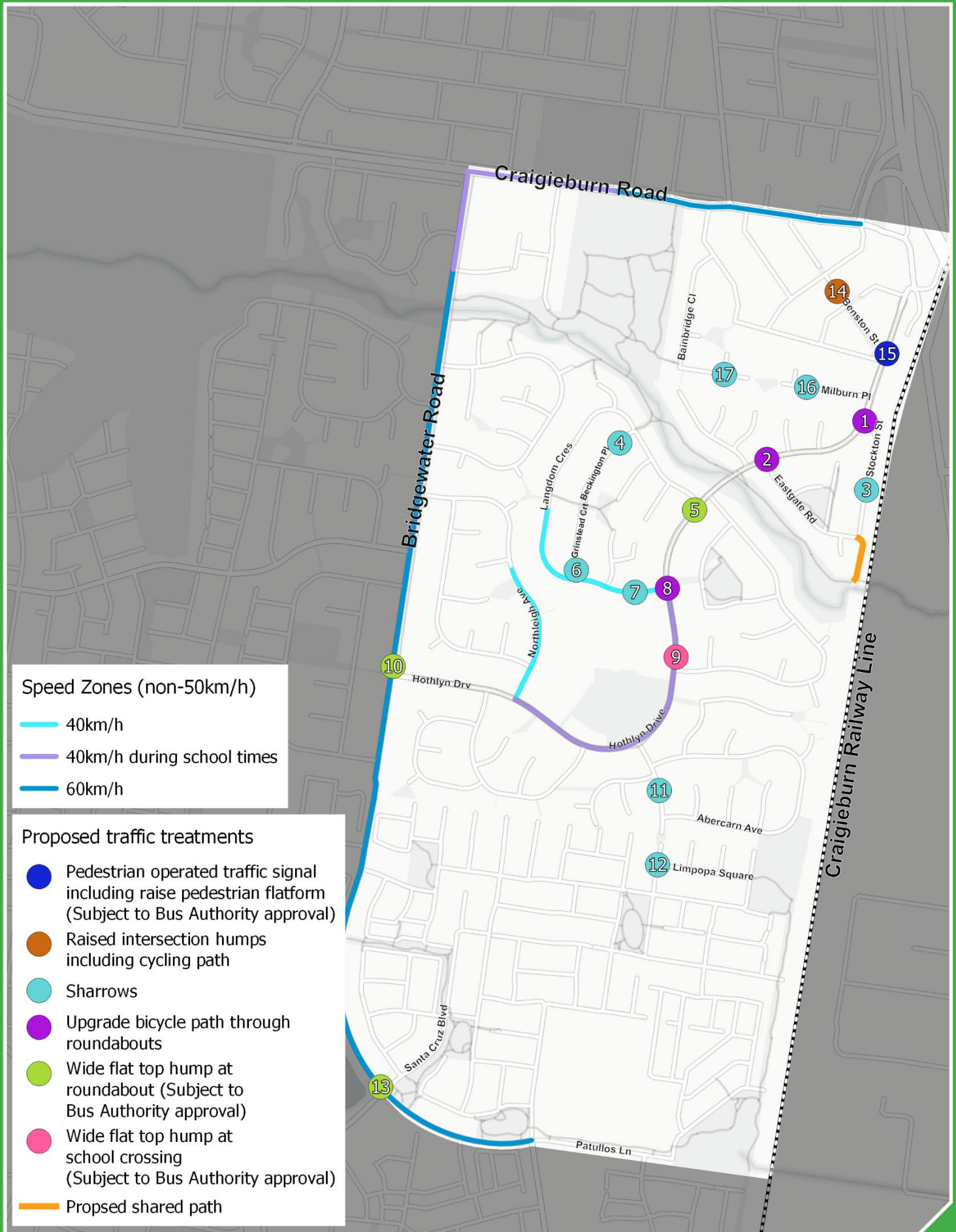

- Wide flat top hump at roundabout (Subject to Bus Authority approval)



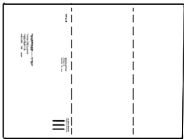
- Wide flat top hump at school crossing (Subject to Bus Authority approval)

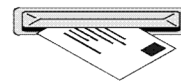
