- Preservation of the habitat for the endangered species the Golden Sun Moth.
- Creek corridor improvements create opportunities to provide a habitat for other endangered species such as the Growling Grass Frog.
- The preservation of existing trees and vegetation where possible.
- The incorporation of water sensitive urban design techniques to improve run off/water quality.
- Active transport infrastructure to be provided, including walking and cycling paths, with better connections to existing pathways.
