TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Standard terms

- 1. Information on the event and ticketing form part of these Terms and Conditions. By purchasing a ticket, you accept these Terms and Conditions.
- 2. The Promoter is Hume City Council (ABN 14854354856) of 1079 Pascoe Vale Road, Broadmeadows.

Variations to performances or events

3. Hume City Council reserves the right to add, withdraw, reschedule or substitute artists and/or vary advertised programs, prices, venues and audience capacity at any time.

Videography and photography

- 4. Photos and videos will be taken at this event for future promotional purposes including on the Council's website and social media.
- 5. By attending the event, you consent to your photo or video being taken. Please advise the photographer, videographer or staff at the event if you do not want to have your photo or video taken.

Conditions of entry

- 6. You may be denied entry into, or removed from, an event where Hume City Council has reasonable grounds to do so, including if you breach these Terms and Conditions, or you are intoxicated, under the influence of illicit drugs, selling or providing illicit drugs or adversely affecting the enjoyment of the event by others.
- 7. Staff reserve the right to perform bag checks before entering the venue. No glass, alcohol, illicit drugs, sharp objects or weapons may be brought into the venue.
- 8. Children under 18 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian at all times while entering, exiting and attending the event.
- 9. Patrons are required to follow all reasonable instructions by event staff, Victoria Police and security while attending the event.
- 10. The event site is located within a residential area. Patrons must not cause undue interference to residents while attending the event or while arriving or departing from the event.
- 11. At no stage may event patrons enter the waterway of Jackson Creek.
- 12. The festival site is grassed with a moderate slope.
- 13. The event site is a non-smoking event except for the designated smoking areas.

Alcohol Consumption

15. Alcohol will be available for sale at the event in open containers from 1.30pm to 9pm and is subject to the conditions of a Liquor Licence issued by the Victorian Commission for Gambling and Liquor.

- 17. Limitations on the number and type of drinks able to be purchased per customer per sale will be enforced. Any such limitations will be communicated to patrons via signage displayed at points-of-sale.
- 18. Any patron found to have bought alcohol into the venue may have the alcohol confiscated and/or asked to leave the venue.

Tickets
