TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Standard terms

1. Information on the event and ticketing form part of these Terms and Conditions. By purchasing a ticket, you accept these Terms and Conditions.
2. The Promoter is Hume City Council (ABN - 14854354856) of 1079 Pascoe Vale Road, Broadmeadows.

Variations to performances or events

3. Hume City Council reserves the right to add, withdraw, reschedule or substitute artists and/or vary advertised programs, prices, venues and audience capacity at any time.

Videography and photography

4. Photos and videos will be taken at this event for future promotional purposes including on the Council's website and social media.
5. By attending the event, you consent to your photo or video being taken. Please advise the photographer, videographer or staff at the event if you do not want to have your photo or video taken.

Conditions of entry

6. You may be denied entry into, or removed from, an event where Hume City Council has reasonable grounds to do so, including if you breach these Terms and Conditions, or you are intoxicated, under the influence of illicit drugs, selling or providing illicit drugs or adversely affecting the enjoyment of the event by others.
7. Staff reserve the right to perform bag checks before entering the venue. No glass, illicit drugs, sharp objects or weapons may be brought into the venue. For the full list of prohibited items visit the event page.
8. Children under 18 must be accompanied and supervised by a parent/guardian at all times while entering, exiting and attending the event.
9. All patrons who are over 18 years old will be required to provide a Valid Photo ID. For more information visit the [Victorian Government's website](#).
10. Patrons are required to follow all reasonable instructions by event staff, Victoria Police and security while attending the event.
11. The event site is located within a residential area. Patrons must not cause undue interference to residents while attending the event or while arriving or departing from the event.
12. At no stage may event patrons enter the waterway of Jackson Creek.
13. The festival site is grassed with a moderate slope.
14. The event site is a non-smoking event except for the designated smoking areas.
15. Council will not be liable for any injury, loss or damage to the participant while attending this event.

Alcohol

16. An application has been made to Liquor Control Victoria for a temporary liquor license to allow attendees to bring their own alcohol to the event. The ability to bring alcohol to this event is dependent on LCV approval.
17. If endorsed, alcohol limits will apply and will be communicated to ticket holders in advance of the event.
18. Alcohol will not be available for sale at the venue.

Tickets

19. Your ticket is proof of purchase for the above event and must be presented at the time of admission.
20. Only one person may enter the event per valid ticket purchased.
21. Tickets are not to be duplicated for the purpose of falsifying entry. All tickets will be scanned upon entry.
22. This ticket may be valid as a tax invoice or receipt in the case of registrations or other event payments.
23. Where this event is cancelled or significantly changed, consumers may have a right to refund.
