
### Welcome to Term 1 2023 and our 13th Edition Newsletter.

As many of you are aware the Preschool-Field Officer (PSFO) program is a free service for all children in funded 3- & 4-year-old kindergarten, including Early Start Kindergarten, regardless of the service type. It is a time limited, capacity building program that includes consultative support, resourcing, and practical advice to assist early childhood educators to support the access, inclusion, and participation of children with additional needs in a kindergarten program. The Preschool Field Officer program is a State Funded program through the Department of Education. Our program is NOT related to or connected to the Victorian Inclusion Agency program which is funded via the Commonwealth.



Dan J. Siegel a neuropsychiatrist describes mental health as our ability to remain in a 'river of wellness'.

Looking at the picture above one side of the riverbank is chaos where there is a lack of control which can result in emotional meltdowns and the other side of the riverbank is rigidity where there is too much control, and this can lead to lack of flexibility and adaptability. Where is ideal is in the middle of the river and not moving too close to either side of the riverbank.

The river of wellness is something that you can refer to regularly to assess yourself, your work colleagues and the children in your care and education services. Then you can take the appropriate action/s for support whether that be through building relationships and offering recommendations for referral pathways.
