  - a. Councillor Dance failed to comply with the Council's internal arbitration process.
- 2. The application includes the following circumstances/actions/inactions alleged as constituting serious misconduct:
  - a. On 20 March 2021, Cr Dance made an application seeking a finding of misconduct against Cr Jack Medcraft alleging a breach of the prescribed standards of conduct.
  - b. The Determination of the hearing was tabled at the Ordinary Meeting of Hume City Council on 12 July 2021 noting no breach of the prescribed standards of conduct and making no finding of misconduct against Cr Medcraft.
  - c. The Arbiter's Determination noted that Cr Dance:
    - i. "Does not appear to have appreciated the importance and seriousness of the process with respect to this matter."
    - ii. "... it is concerning that the applicant failed to comply with the Council internal arbitration process (a process which in this case was initiated by him) by not complying [with] the Arbiter's directions that the parties attend the directions hearing and the hearing in person."
